

1. Are all students required to return to Campus for teaching and learning activities for the new semester admission in 2021?

Yes - student admissions to Campus for teaching and learning activities will be done in phases via hybrid mode commencing March 2021.

Students will be receiving a detailed plan with the schedule, permission letters to be in campus, and student guidelines from respective schools. Those who are unable to come back to campus for various reasons are requested to get in touch with your Programme Directors immediately.

Out-of-town students may opt to travel back to Selangor from mid-February 2021.

2. Will the cost of back-to-campus movement for students be borne by the Government?

No - cost is to be borne by students.

3. Are face-to-face teaching and learning activities allowed for students returning to campus?

Yes - hybrid learning (online and face-to-face learning) is set to commence in March 2021.

4. Are students from Red Zones required to be present on Campus?

Yes - students from Red Zones can be present on Campus. However, this group of students must return earlier to undergo a 10-day isolation at designated facilities.

More information on standard operating procedures (SOPs) and isolation process will be shared in separate announcement.

5. What safety measures should be taken by students living off-campus?

Off-campus students should continue to follow new normal SOPs in their daily routine, which includes practicing social distancing, using face masks, and maintaining good personal hygiene.
