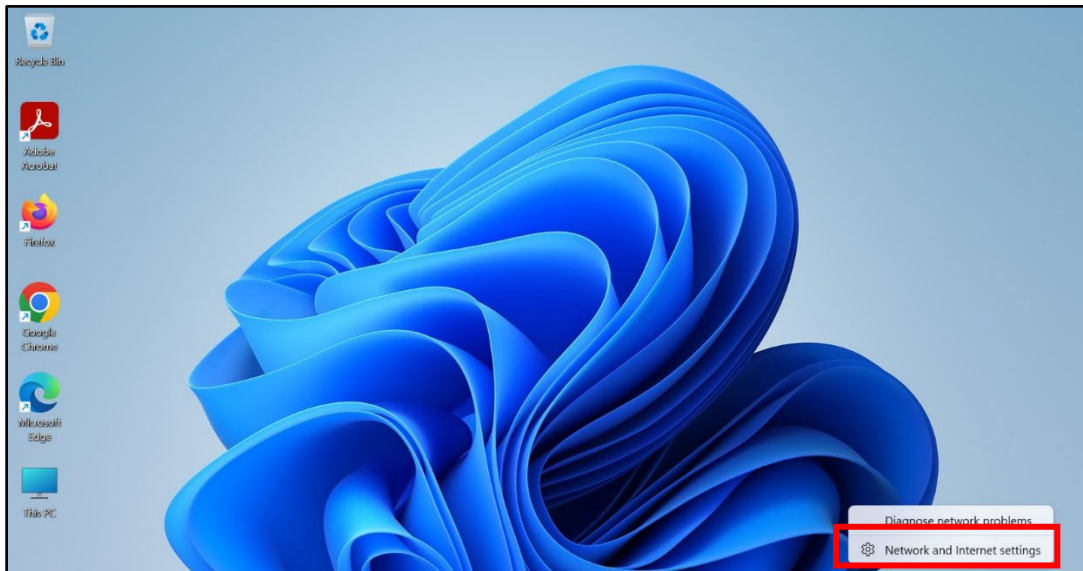
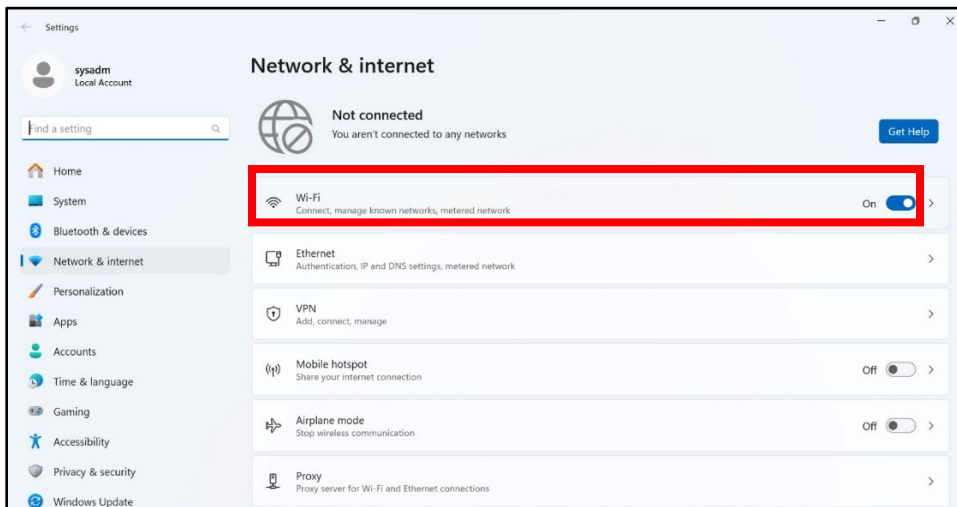


How to Connect to “Taylors Student” Wifi on Windows 11

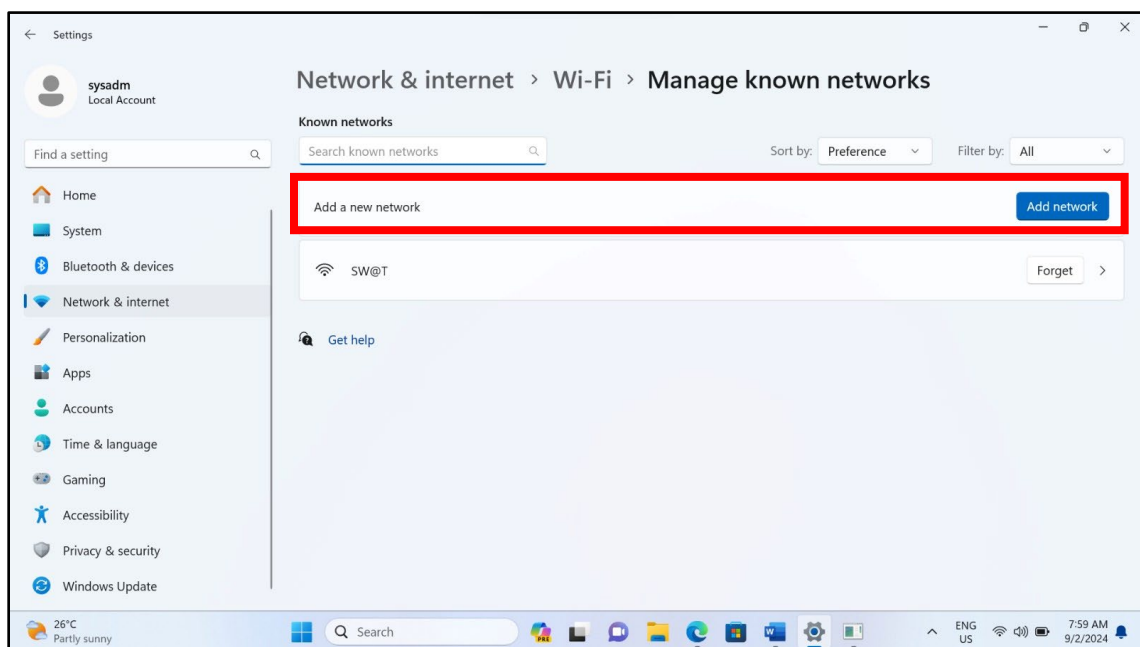
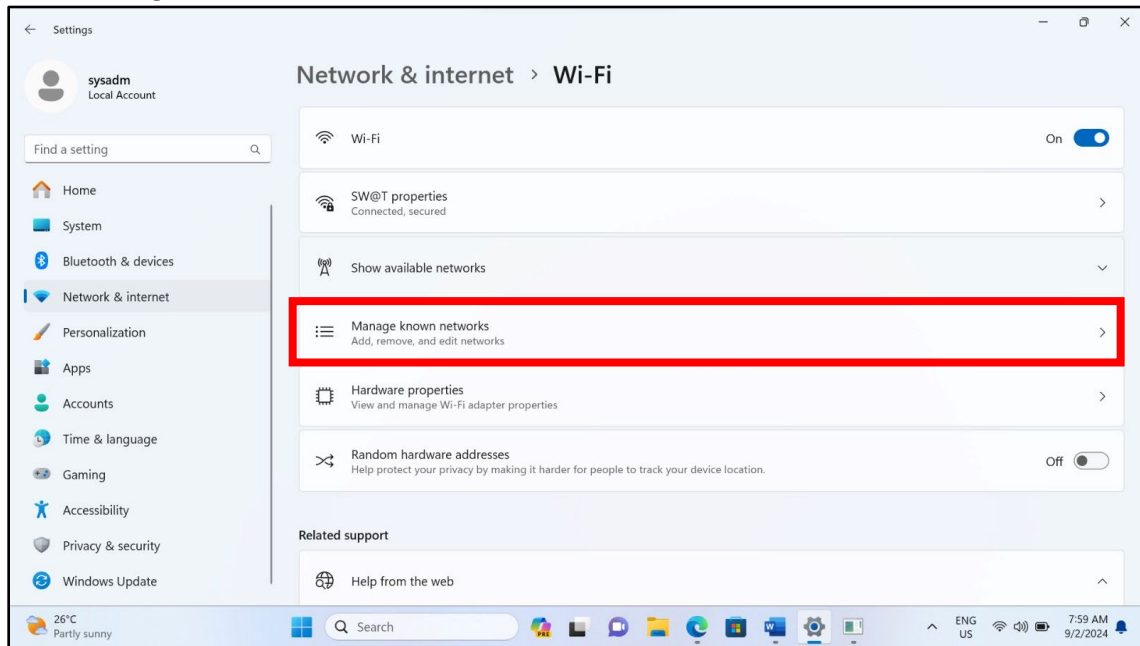
1. Mouse over to the Network Connection Icon located at the bottom right of your screen. Click on it to open the Network and Internet Settings.



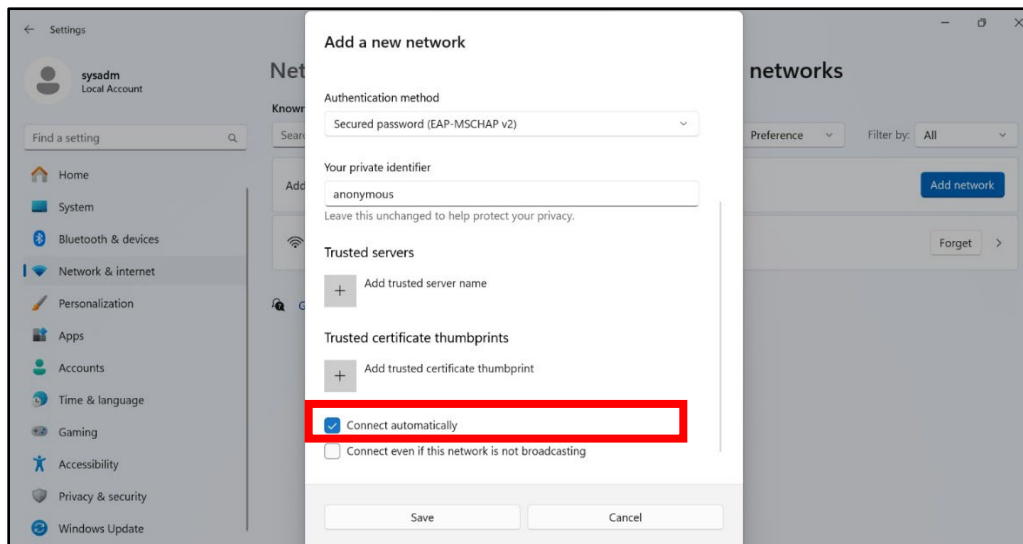
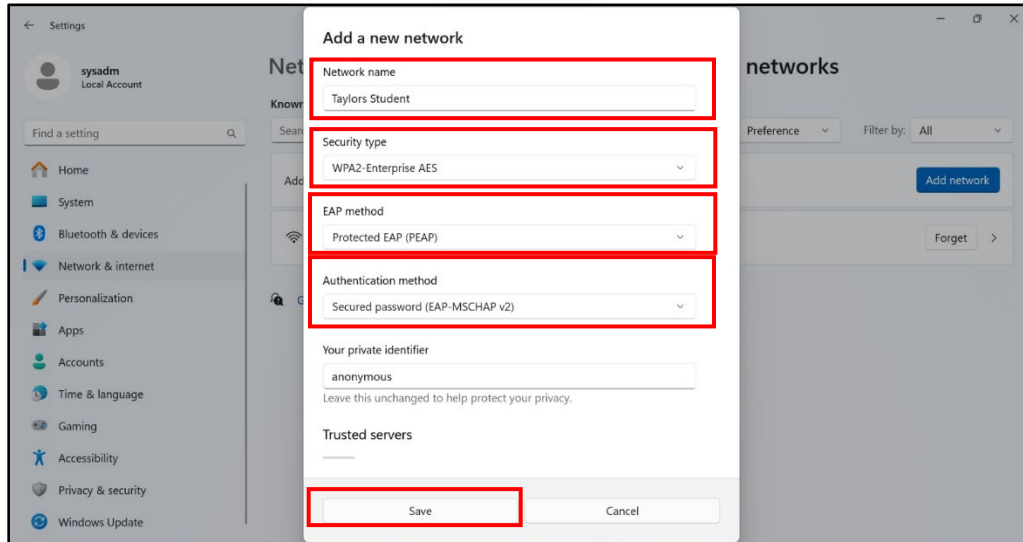
2. Click on “Wi-Fi”.



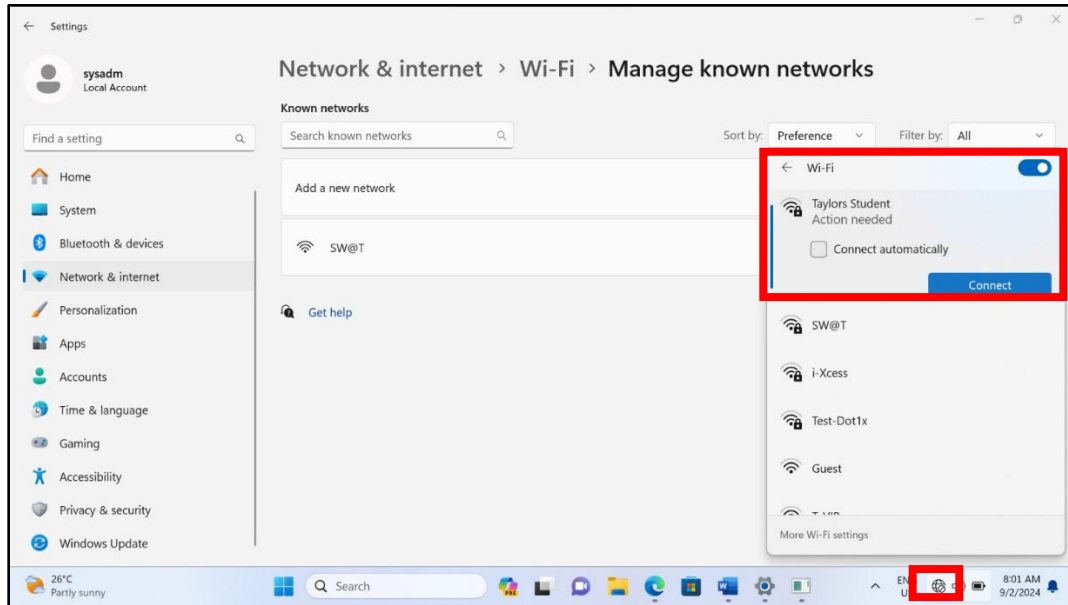
3. Click **“Manage known networks”** then **“Add a New Network”**.



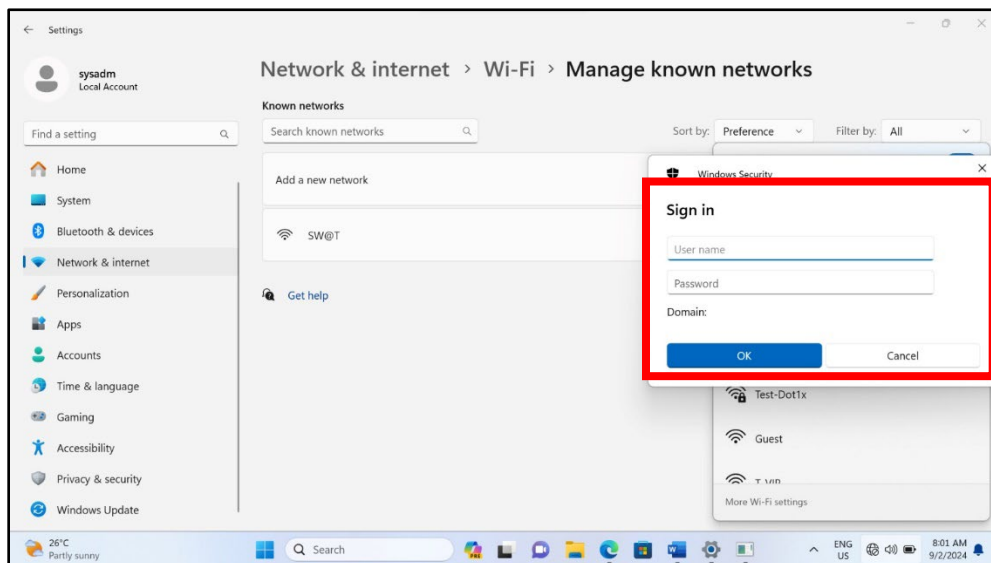
4. Make sure your settings are as below.
- a) Verify that the **Network name (SSID)** is set to **Taylor's Student**
 - b) **Security Type** is set to **WPA2-Enterprise AES**
 - c) **EAP method** is set to **Protected EAP (PEAP)**.
 - d) **Authentication method** is set to **MSCHAPV2**.
 - e) Check on **"Connect Automatically"**
 - f) Click on **"Save"** to bring you to next configuration page



5. Now click on the Globe icon on the bottom right of your desktop screen and Click on **"Taylors Student"**.

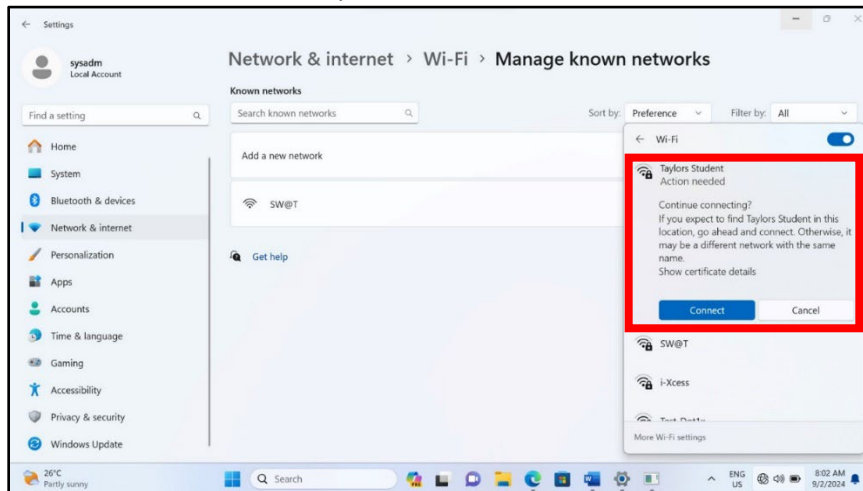


6. Enter your username and password, click the "OK" button to proceed

Password : (Student Email Password)

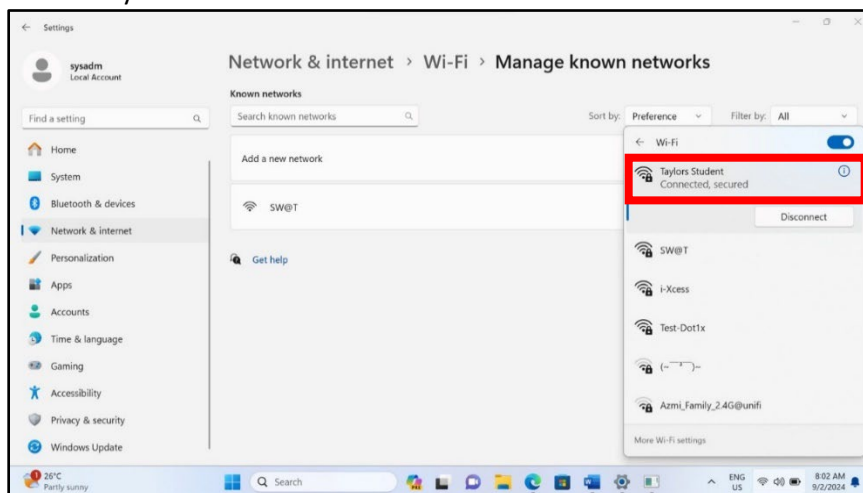




- After entering your username and password, a "Action Needed" box will appear. In this box, click on the **"Connect"** button to proceed.
